Cleanliness

Bathrooms, bunks, dining hall — the unstaged corners.

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Safety & health

Food safety (is the mayo out in the sun?), clean infirmary, doctor on premises or on call, nearest-hospital plan.

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Staff nights out

Who watches the bunk when counselors are off? Alcohol policy when they return?

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Activities & facilities

Real programs your kid would love, equipment cared for and put away.

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The kids look happy & friendly

Ask a camper the best AND worst part of camp — kids answer honestly.

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Director knows the campers

Does the director call kids by name as you walk? The clearest sign there is.

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Staff engagement

Counselors IN it with the kids — or standing off to the side in a clump?

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Camp spirit

Did you hear the camp cheer? Singing, lineup energy?

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Trips & buses

Destinations? Licensed & insured buses (FMCSA)? Which hotels — inside-entrance only, no balconies? Staff in-room or adjacent? Floor security at night?

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The real price

All-inclusive, or are trips, canteen & laundry extra? Get the true total.

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Communication with parents

Photos, updates, homesickness plan, medication & dietary needs handling.

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Your gut feeling

Could you picture your child running to that waterfront?
